Veridian Healthstream d.o.o. has successfully completed the EU project

Strengthening the competitiveness of Veridian Healthstream through the certification of management systems according to ISO 30301:2019, ISO 42001:2023, ISO 20000-1:2018 and ISO 14001:2015, project code PK.1.3.04.0176.

The project was implemented in accordance with the rules of the Call for Proposals for the award of grants “Support to enterprises for product certification and the introduction of management systems”, under the Competitiveness and Cohesion Programme 2021–2027.

Total project value – EUR 162,109.20.

EU co-financing – EUR 98,553.71.

Project implementation period – from 1 June 2025 to 1 June 2026.

During the implementation of the project, Veridian Healthstream d.o.o. drew down the full amount of EUR 98,553.71 in grant funding, meaning that the project was financially implemented in full, in accordance with the approved funds and implementation rules.

The objective of the project was to increase the international competitiveness of Veridian Healthstream d.o.o. through the establishment and certification of management systems for the environment, IT services, records and artificial intelligence. Through the implementation of the project, the company improved its internal business processes, strengthened its management practices and further aligned its operations with internationally recognised standards relevant for operating in foreign markets.

As part of the project, the planned certification objectives were successfully achieved and four certificates were issued:

- ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System
- ISO 20000-1:2018 IT Service Management System
- ISO 30301:2019 Management System for Records
- ISO/IEC 42001:2023 Artificial Intelligence Management System

It is particularly important to note that, during the implementation of the project, the beneficiary successfully carried out a publicly announced procurement procedure, in accordance with the Rules on conducting procurement procedures for entities not subject to the Public Procurement Act. This ensured the transparent and proper
